(d)	Addition of Core Course Option for M.Tech. (ESD)	On Program coordinators recommendations, IQAC committee suggested to seek approval in next senate meeting for the same.

(a)	Research office proposed a plan to organize faculty talks on the recent research works	Research office presented a plan to organize faculty talks in the Institute on the latest developments/ progress in research areas of the faculty and Research scholars. After detailed discussions, the IQAC committee recommended to start the talks which would benefit the student's community.
(b)	Preparation & Submission of details for AICTE approval	Registrar informed the IQAC committee regarding the need for preparation and submission of requisite data to AICTE for approvals of iMTech and MTech programs, after the discussions, Director suggested Registrar and Dean (Academics) to take this work forward.
(c)	Establishing of Research centers/Labs in the emerging areas	Dean (R & D) explained the need of labs on emerging and thrust areas and presented a plan.  Director suggested Dean (R & D) to seek proposals from the faculty members.

(d)	Planning on implementation of Digital exams on trial mode	Dean (Academics) suggested his plan to conduct the examination in the digital mode using the digital pads and he also explained the advantages of conducting examinations in digital mode. After discussions IQAC suggested to go with the trial mode.
(e)	Technology up gradation in the concerned areas	IQAC and Alumni members suggested for Technology upgradation in all departments, for better day-to-day working activities.
